

Follow this diagram to adjust your cabinet and hutch doors.

Note: Over time, your doors may shift or sag. This does not mean that the hinges have worn out - they simply need adjusting.



1) Sideways / Tilt adjustment

Turn the screw:

U **Clockwise** to move the door further away from the side of the cabinet. U **Anti-clockwise** to move the door closer to the side of the cabinet.



4 Height Adjustment

While supporting the weight of the door, turn the screws:

- ${\mathbb U}$ Clockwise to move the door up.
- $\ensuremath{\mathfrak{O}}$ Anti-clockwise to move the door down.

(3) Forward and back adjustment

If the gap between the back of the door and the cabinet is too small, the door may not close fully. Turn the screw:

 $\ensuremath{\mathbb{U}}$ Clockwise to decrease the gap between the door and the cabinet.

 ${\tt C}$ Anti-clockwise to increase the gap between the door and the cabinet.
